In reply to your letter of th twentieth of this month, yes, you were listening to WCLH, 90.7, Wilkes-Barre, Pa. I have gone over our logs for the day in question, and you are to be commended for the accuracy with which you noted our broadcast. I could not find any errors what-so-ever.

In answer to your other questions, we transmit at an assigned frequency of 90.7 megaHertz, with a vertical power of 175 watts and a horizontal power of 175 watts. Our antenna is located on Electronic Heights, Pa. and has a height of 829 feet atmosth latitudes 41 degrees, 10 minutes, and 58 seconds; west longitude 75 degrees, 52 minutes, and 21 seconds.

Thank you for your correspondance, and attention to our station. Being an educational station, we rarely get to hear from our public as much as we would like. To be contacted by a member of an organization as esteemed as yours is indeed a rare pleasure. Best of luck in future frequency hunting and again, thank you.
