Dear Mr. Geary:

I am pleased to confirm your reception of WEAZ from 1:46 to 2:45 PM, March 9, 1984.

Our General Manager, Jim DeCaro and I appreciate your thoughtful comments and are impressed that you should be able to receive us so well.

It may interest you to know that we are just completing a new transmitter site that should afford you even better reception in the future. WEAZ broadcasts from a tower located at 329 Domino Lane in Roxborough, Philadelphia. Our signal is multiplexed with two other stations, WSNI-FM (on 104.5 MHz) and WMGK-FM's auxiliary transmitter (not normally operating on our antenna but located at 102.9 MHz). The common antenna is mounted at approximately 1100 feet, and we broadcast with an effective radiated power of 12.5 Kilowatts.
