Dear Mr. Geary:

Thank you for your letter of December 11th and report of the reception of the WFMZ programs on Sunday, December 10th. The log you sent is correct in all respects.

We are happy to hear that we are providing a good signal in your area and that everything is satisfactory technically.

We are using a Collins model 732-A transmitter which is rated at 1 kw output but we are operating it at about 930 watts output because of F. C. C. limits on power at this height. Our effective radiated power is 4.8 kw, which is the maximum allowed for our antenna height in this part of the country. The antenna is 835 feet above average terrain. The antenna is 346 feet above ground level. The base of the tower is 997 feet above mean sea level.
