This is to verify your report of the reception of Station WHLM-FM on August 1, 1965 from approximately 5:45 to 7:06 p.m.

WHLM-FM has just recently installed a vertical antenna with an ERP of 4.8 kw and believe that your AC power antenna picked up our vertical signal. It's surprising that you were able to do so as I know the area that you live in very well. We have not changed our horizontal ERP which is still at the old 8.8 kw. Last Fall we installed a new transmitter and believe this has helped our signal tremendously. We, of course, went from 3 kw to 5 kw on our transmitter so that we would have sufficient output for both our vertical and horizontal antenna.
