This letter is to confirm your reception of WHYW on February 10 and February 15. Thank you for continuing to listen for our station and sending reception reports. It is always good to hear from distant places that can receive the station.

We have made a change in the technical operation of our FM station, WHYW-FM. On Friday, February 18, we began broadcasting from a new tower, some 425 feet higher than the old one. We run 15 kW effective radiated power at 930 feet above average terrain (approx. 2050 feet above sea level). The frequency is 96.9 MHz. Perhaps you might receive the station now under the right conditions.
