Thank you for your reception report on WXKW. I'm sure you are aware that your letter does not constitute a DX Report since you receive us well within our primary service area. However, your log accuratly reflects our programming from 11:57 A.M. to 12:36 P.M. on January 1, 1978.

I was interested to note your mention of the fact that WXKW was an AM station on 590 kilohertz in the late 1940's. If my information is correct, those call letters were at one time assigned to a station in the Albany-Troy, New York area. I believe that station's call letters are now WROW. I would be interested in hearing from you if you have any different or additional information on the matter.

Technically, WXKW is a Class B FM station operating in Channel 281 at a frequency on 104.1 megahertz with an Effective Radiated Power of 50,000 watts.

We wish you a belated Happy New Year and continued success in the area of DX Reporting. May I add, letters and reports such as yours are always encouraging and greatly appreciated.
