Thank you very much for the reception report.

I am pleased to confirm your reception of our signal between 2:45 and 3:56 P.M. E.S.T. on March 7, 1971.

Our transmitter is a 10,000 watt Collins Feeding A 10 Bay antenna with center spacing approximately 350 Feet above ground, giving us an effective radiated power of 80,000 watts.

You may be interested to know that the mode of propagation that you received our signal on is called "TROP". This is not a skip signal as such, but rather extended ground wave via Tropospheric ducting or bending.

I would like to wish you good luck with your hobby.
