Replying to your letter of January 14th in which you stated that you received KGZD on January 13th between 3:52 and 4:08AM, we have checked our log and find that your reception was correct. We appreciate your fine report of our radio station and are enclosing photographs of our equipment with an explanation on the rear of each.

KGZD is licensed and is operated with 500 watts of power output. The station serves all of San Diego County with a population of approximately 500,000 people. The terrain we cover is mountainous and filled with valleys which necessitates several repeater stations to assure complete reception from our mobile units. 90% of our mobile units are composite and constructed in our own shops as well as our mobile receivers. We also have several motorcycles which are equipped with transmitting equipment.
