DEAR MR. GEARY:

IN REPLY TO YOUR LETTER OF MARCH 20 I WISH TO ADVISE YOU THAT EVERY THING YOU HAVE DOWN ON YOUR LOG IS CORRECT EXCEPT ONE DISPATCH. THAT IS AT 7:55 AND THAT ITEM WAS NOT GIVEN THIS STATION. HOWEVER YOU MIGHT HAVE HEARD FULTON COUNTY STATION GIVE THIS ITEM. BUT ITEM IN QUESTION WAS NOT GIVEN AS I WAS THE OPERATOR ON WATCH AND MY LOG DOES NOT SHOW IT EITHER.

I AM GLAD TO HEAR THAT WE ARE COMING IN SO GOOD UP THERE AND TRUST THAT WE MAY BE ABLE TO KEEP IT UP. HOWEVER WE HAVE A VERY HIGH NOISE LEVEL HERE IN THE EVENINGS AND NORTH CAROLINA DROWNS US OUT A LOT AT NIGHT.

I HAVE BEEN A TROOPER ON THE GA STATE PATROL FOR SIX YEARS, BUT DUE TO SHORTAGES ETC I HAVE BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THE RADIO DIVISION. AND MUCH TO MY SORRY I DO NOT KNOW A HELLVA LOT ABOUT RADIO. AS I HAVE BEEN OPERATOR EXACTLY 4 WEEKS. SO YOU CAN JUDGE BY THAT.

WE OPERATE ON 1666 KC WITH A POWER OF 1000 WATTS AND ATLANTA IS NET STATION. WE HAVE 5 STATIONS INCLUDING ATLANTA WGSP-WSIN-GRIFFIN-WSIO-WASHINGTON-WSIJ-SWAINSBORO-WSIK-ALBANY. OUR RECEIVERS ARE ONE HOWARD MODEL 490 AND ONE SUPER SKYRIDER MODEL SX-28.

WILL KEEP YOUR LETTER AND LET OUR RADIO REPAIR MAN WRITE YOUR MORE DETAILS. GLAD TO HEAR FROM YOU.
