We are glad to have your comments on the reception from Police Radio Station WPDZ. The Central Station Transmitter is one built by RCA and installed in this office in 1931. The power is 200 watts.

In our Police Communications Net we have 48 mobile units of the Police, Fire, and Sheriff's Departments equipped with radio receivers. 45 of these units have two-way equipment.

I have checked the log for April 20th and find you have a very complete and accurate account of it for the time as given.
