Dear Sir;

Your letter of March 16, 1944 has been brought to my attention and in reply I wish to thank you very much for the complete report on the signal of the Malden Police Radio station WSVC.

The main station, operating on 1714 kc. is a 50 Watt A.M. transmitter built of composite parts (mostly National) and is used by both the Police and Fire Departments.

The mobile units are 12 in number, and are 15 Watt A.M. assemblies operating on a frequency of 33,220 kc.

The antenna system at the main station is a vertical steel tower eighty five feet high, mounted on the Police Station (a two story building) and tuned to produce a strong ground wave, which makes your report very interesting.
