Your letter of April 14 has been forwarded to our radio dep't by Chief of Police William Birney for confirmation of your radio log.

We checked your log on transmissions from WPFE and find it to be correct, and we wish to thank you for the excellent report on our signals.

Our transmitter is an R.C.A. 100 watt unit with a quarter wave vertical antenna. The mobile fleet consists of ten two-way cars with Western Electric 5 watt transmitters, six one-way cars, and three motorcycles equipped with receivers.
