Dear Mr. Geary:

Thank you for your letter of April 5th reporting reception of signals from WPGK. Your log checks with our own.

A brief description of our equipment follows:
Station transmitter 50 watts AM. Nine cars equipped with Link 25 watt FM transmitters. In addition to transmitter at headquarters we have four monitoring receivers operating continuously. These monitoring receivers operate on 31,780 kc., 2466 kc., 1714kc., and 1630 kc. We make our own frequency measurements using a link D-2 Frequency Meter. WPGK was put in operation on November 1, 1933. Two way was installed about four years ago.

I am sure you would find great enjoyment in Amateur radio. Perhaps after the war we will contact each other via the Ham Bands. My Amateur station call is WIAFO.

Your log sheet shows careful monitoring. I wish you continued success.
