Thank you very much for your letter giving the information on the reception of our transmitter "WSYC". We are glad to receive communications of this type as we feel that it gives us an informal check on our transmissions.

Our log checks with the calls that you have recorded as to time, location, etc.

"WSYC" is a composite transmitter constructed by our staff and is operated by remote control from our headquarters, the control room being located downtown and the transmitter at a precinct station uptown. We have a power of 500 watts.

"WPHF" is still in operation, but is used mostly as a reserve transmitter.

We hope along with you and all Americans that this war will soon end in a glorious victory, so that we may all go back to doing the things we like.
