Dear Mr. Geary:

This is to verify your reception report of the Norfolk Marine Operator at 0606-0614 EST, March 11, 1980 and 0610-0618 EST, March 12, 1980, on 2538 KiloHertz.

Our WGB transmitter is located at Virginia Beach, Virginia, with the control terminal and operators located in Norfolk approximately 24 miles away. The transmitter puts out about 100 watts single-sideband. Our antenna is a shunt-fed vertical monopole.

WAE is located at Point Harbor, North Carolina about 60 miles south. The same operators here in Norfolk operate that station, too.

For your interest, I am enclosing a map showing other Coastal Harbor Stations. Your local telephone company business office may have their correct addresses which should speed any replies.
