Dear Mr. Geary:

This confirms your reception of Station WOU Channel 2 transmissions on the carrier frequency of 2450KHz during the morning of March 4, 1980.

The Station is operated by New England Telephone and Telegraph Company and consists of Western Electric single sideband transmitters with a peak envelope power of 400 watts. There are two transmitting locations, one at Marshfield, MA and the other at Narragansett, R.I.

The antenna at Marshfield is a 206 ft. tower. At Narragansett it is a 100 ft. monopole.

The information you heard on the air was our standard transmission of time, temperature and notices to mariners which are regularly provided as a public service.

We thank you for advising us of your excellent reception of Station WOU and hope this confirmation will assist you in your use and enjoyment of the radio channels.
