Acknowledging receipt of your kind letter dated Oct. 7, 1957, we thank you very much for the description of your receiving equipments and your correct report. We would like to inform you that the transmission observed from you on Oct. 6 between 1200 and 1216 hours GMT has been emitted from our Bonames transmitting station near Frankfurt (Main). The call sign of the transmitter concerned is DFT94, its carrier frequency 19947 kc/s, its power 20 kW, and its normal schedule 1200 - 2000 hours GMT daily. It is using the class of emission 10A3b; i.e. a single sideband telephone system (with four channels) occupying a band of \pm 5 kc/s. The aerial is a ordinary rhombic antenna directed to 294 degrees (clockwise) from true north.

We hope that the above will be of any use to you.
