Daily broadcasting by the BBC began on the 14th  
November 1922 from the tiny London Station 2LO,  
with a total staff of 4. Today the staff numbers 24,000  
and the BBC TV and Radio services are known through-  
out the world. The BBC World Service alone commands  
an audience of at least 40 million, produces more than  
100,000 world news bulletins, press reviews and news  
commentaries for overseas listeners each year, and  
presents more than 45,000 programmes a year including  
political, scientific, literary, music and general  
entertainment.
