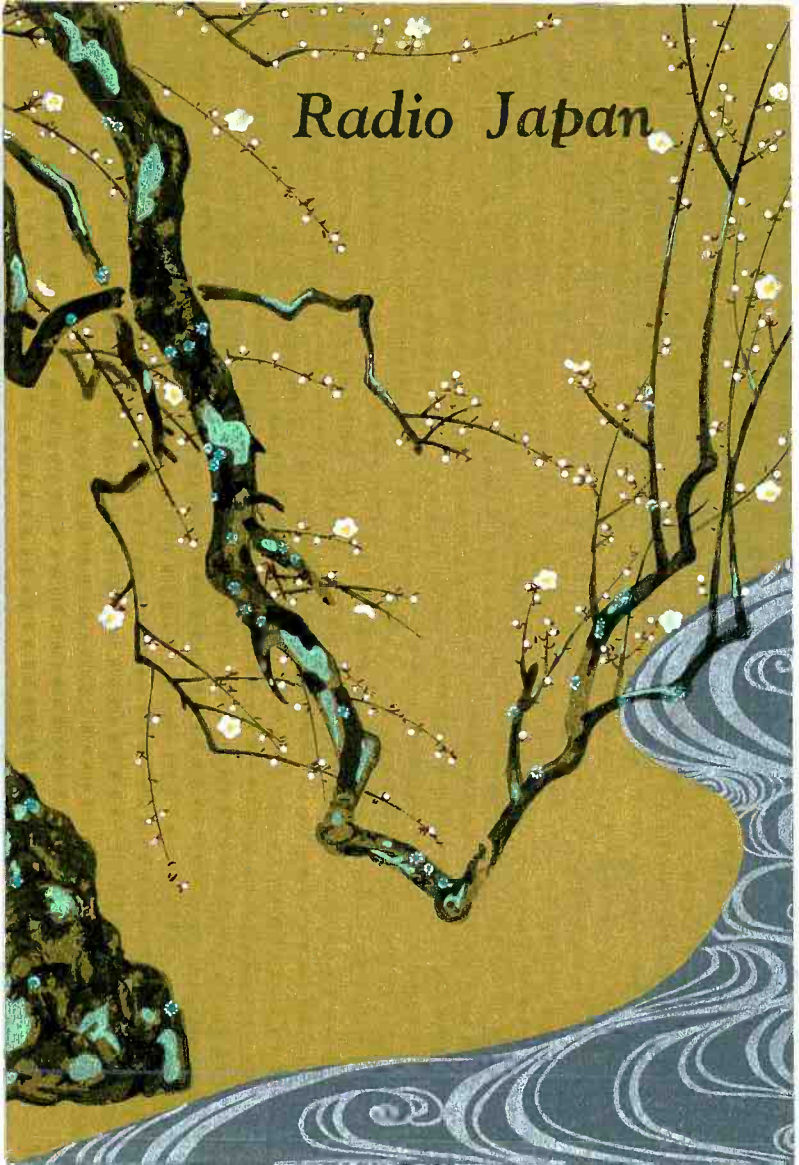

This is one of his masterpieces, which is widely known as the finest of screen paintings. The manner of painting the water is unique to this painter and is known under the name of "Korin pattern". He is widely known now since some of his works have been adopted for Japanese stamps.
