Radio New Ireland is one of the nineteen (19) Provincial Stations of the National Broadcasting Commission (NBC) of Papua New Guinea. It broadcasts on a frequency of 3905 Kltz in the 75 Metre band and an aerial power of 10 KW.

1700 - 2300 GMT


We are proud that Radio New Ireland can be also heard in Pennsylvania, USA.
