Dear Sir,

We thank you for your letter of 17th ult. with report of our programme on the same day, over LKJ-1.

We are pleased to hear that your reception was relatively good, not daring to expect that from our sender-power of only 1 KW. In this connection we may mention our plans for a new Norwegian short-wave-sender of 5 KW's antenna-effect now being prepared, hoping to be able to build the new station in a not too far off future. That station ready you may count upon a surer reception of our ordinary programmes.

As to special programmes for Norwegian listeners in America, in conformity with our trial-sending on the 17th ult., we must say, that we would naturally like to establish regular sendings, but the realization of this plan chiefly depends on the license-authorities.

As a matter of fact the broadcasting in this country requires a very large amount, especially to the technical service in the country, and it is impossible to say when the short-wave-programmes eventually could be arranged for our compatriots in America in a more regular way. However, as mentioned, this question has our whole sympathy.

Thanking you again for your kind letter, we beg to add, that we have checked your log with our station-log, and it shows quite conforme to the programmes dispatched.
