
I am pleased to be able to confirm  
your reception report for January 8, 1980.

CHQT radio in Edmonton, Alberta  
operates on an assigned frequency of 1110 KHZ  
at a daytime power of 50 KW omnidirectional and  
at a night time power of 50 KW directional, thus  
making CHQT a 50 KW DA-N CLASS II station. Our  
transmitter site and four tower array is located  
several miles south and east of the city of  
Edmonton with the exact geographical location  
being latitude 53° 27' 55" north, longitude  
113° 19' 50" west.

CHQT's programming policy is geared  
to the adult listener in our coverage area. It  
consists of "Middle of the Road" easy listening  
music with a minimum of talk by announcers and  
authoritative newsmen.

It is always most interesting and
