THANK YOU FOR SENDING US YOUR RECEPTION REPORT! SORRY IT TOOK SO LONG TO RETURN REPLY. WTAK HAS BEEN ROCKING SINCE SUMMER OF 1987 AND WE ARE THE ONLY AOR STATION IN NORTH ALABAMA. I BET THE OTHER STATION FROM ALABAMA WAS WAAY. UNFORTUNATLY THEY GAVE UP AND SIGNED OFF OVER SIX MONTHS AGO. THEIR FREQUENCY WAS 1550 AND THEY HAD 50,000 WATTS DAY AND 500 NIGHT. I WORKED THERE ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS WHERE BAD WEATHER ALLOWED US TO BE ON HIGH POWER. AND CALLS CAME IN FROM EVERYWHERE INCLUDING A CALLER FROM COLORADO THAT I PUT ON THE AIR. IT'S BAD THAT THEY SIGNED OFF BECAUSE THEY HAD HIGH POTENTIAL TO CHANGE THEIR LICENSE TO 50,000 DAY 5000,NIGHT! WTAK IS A 10Kw DIRECTIONAL DAYTIME STATION. WE HAV<sup>E</sup> BEEN ON AN OMNI DIRECTIONAL PATTERN FOR A LONG TIME BECAUSE ONE OF OUR THREE TOWERS FELL. THAT WAS NICE BUT CAUSED INTERFERENCE SO WE HAVE LOWERD POWER TO APPROX 4,5 Kw UNTIL THE NEW TOWER IS IN PLACE. IF YOU CAN RECIEVE US AT THAT POWER PLEASE LET US KNOW! SIGN ON FOR FEBUARY IS AT 6:30 CDT AND SIGN OFF IS AT 5:30 PM.
