
Dear Wayne,

Thank you for your reception report of KAZM on May 9, 1984. Let this letter serve as official confirmation of reported reception of KAZM from 6:59 p.m. to 7:11 p.m. MST.

For back-ground, KAZM operates with 5,000 watts day power and 250 watts directional, night power. In compliance with F.C.C. regulations, KAZM protects the Reno, Nevada and Chicago, Illinois stations on 780 kh. Consequently at sunset we drop power and go directional, that is 7:00 p.m. in April.
