- 10:46pm Promo for KNST Christmas with schedual of shows for Christmas day... Faded out during this announcement.

I heard KNST on a 23 tube triple conversion Army surplus R-390A/URR with a 15" loop antenna. My location is on the north edge of downtown Colorado Springs about 15 minutes from the foot of Pike's Peak.
