Thank you for your signal report, of the test broadcast presented for the National Radio Club, on the 16th of February.


Please find enclosed, a copy of the test program log. You will note that in addition to the code ID's, there were oral ID'S and other test data given, including Country-Western music selections.

One very important point I might mention, that regardless of what programming we were using, the code ID was continuous in the background, and also filling in the dead spots between the various bits of program material. Also the test tones used, were so chosen as not to detract from the 1-khz code tone. The coded ID was a continuous tape loop, with the characters: "K-W-I-P--1-5-8-O-K-H-Z".
