Dear Sir,

I am very pleased to report reception of KEXO on 1/9/78 from 12:17a until 12:21am MST on 1230 kHz. Your signal was fair to poor with QRM from semi-local KDZA in Pueblo. The following are the details of my reception:

- 12:17a End of tone ID This is KEXO, Grand Junction Colorado conducting a frequency measurement test... then more tone
- 12:21a Tone ended and heard faint beginning of ID way under KDZA then nothing else....KDZA took over

I was using a Navy surplus receiver with a 4' loop antenna. I'm located on the near north side of Colorado Springs.

I was wondering if this frequency test is held on a regular basis, and if so when. I would pass this along to the National Radio Club for publication. This information may allow other DX'ers needing KEXO to hear and verify your station. I've been a DX'er for 13 years since 1975 in Colorado Springs, and I'm presently a advertising specialties salesman with Motivational Communications Inc.
