
6:14 AM Tune into Mexican music.

Equipment in use while listening to KJME consisted of a WWII surplus Navy RBB-4 and a R-390A/URR Army surplus receiver with a 4' box loop antenna and a 100' long wire run through a phasing network. By trade I'm a real estate appraiser and have been a BCB DX'er since 1964.
