I am very pleased to report reception this morning of KLOV on 1570 kHz on 12-18-79 from 7:40am-7:45am MST. KLOV has been one of my long sought catches in my attempt to hear all of Colorado. Due to 5 kw KPIK on 1580 having there non directional XMTR about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  miles NNW of me it makes it difficult to null there splatter and still get any intelégable copy on KLOV. I would like to offer the following details of your programing as proof of this reception:

7:40am Tune in to Live report  
7:41am Spot for ????? Subara Dealership 401 South Hampton & return to Live weather from US Weather Service for KLOV. This followed imediately by a spot for Fergusson's True Value Hardware  
7:42 $\frac{1}{2}$  Instrumental music  
7:45am The Bill(?) Warmup Realty show... guest representative from Warmup realty was interviewed on air... end of good copy.

I've been trying since moving to C. Springs in 1975 to hear KLOV and finally I believe I have good enough data to report. I use a 1943 Navy surplus receiver with a Army surplus tank radio as a Q\*5'er (the result is 6 IF stages, dual conversion) along with a 15" ferrite core loop antenna (Radio West of California Model MW-1) I'm located on the north side of the springs 6 blocks east of the Uintah exit of I-25. I'm also a member of the National Radio Club the worlds oldest and largest all BCB DX Club.

Please find enclosed return postage for your convience, I'd appreciate a verification from KLOV to add to my collection if this report is found correct. I recently met some folks from the Loveland area at the local Assessor's office, we all attended school in Boulder this past October, I work as an appraiser for El Paso County Assessor's office. Thank you in advance for your time and consideration in anwsering this letter and helping me with my hobby.
