KVCU definitely is different from the rest of the Metro areas stations. The signal here is always good. Although at almost 50 years old I find it hard to appreciate some of the music, some of the folk stuff that is played is nice. My main purpose in writing is to obtain a verification of the KVCU call, to add it to my KADE and KBCO calls from the past.
