This letter is to verify your reception report of KYOU Radio on October 12th, 1983. Your report is accurate for our programming on that day.

Our transmitter is located about two miles north west of downtown Greeley. We are using a Gates BC-1T Transmitter at 250 watts night and 1,000 watts day, non-directional. Our Antenna is about 340 feet tall, 5/8 wave. We currently sign on at 5:30AM and broadcast until midnight, although plans are for 24 hour operation.

Thankyou for your nice letter. I too have dabbled in DXing and find it to be a very rewarding hobby. I only wish I had more time for it. The biggest thrill here at KYOU was a reception report and audio tape from Sweden! Who says you can't do anything with 250 watts!

Pass along that the FCC is now authorizing daytimers to operate up to two hours after sun set with 50 to 500 watts. Should make for some great DXing.
