This letter confirms reception by you, or radio station W.C.O.A.
on December 6, 1965.

WCOA is one of Florida's oldest radio stations, having been broadcasting since 1926. We operate with a full time power of 5,000 watts on 1370 kilocycles. Our transmitter is located in Warrington, Florida, a few hundred feet from the waters of Bayou Chico, which empties into Pensacola Bay a half mile away. We maintain a non-directional daytime pattern, and are directional with a three tower array at night, protecting stations in Tennessee, South Carolina, and the west coast. Our power at night primarily is aimed at South Florida and the Caribbean, besides our own local area.

We hope this letter will be sufficient to be confirmation for your radio log.
