
Dear Wayne Heinen,
Thank you for your interest and confirmation report.

KBLI operates with 10,000 watts daytime and 1,000 watts nighttime from its transmitter site 1 mile south of Blackfoot, Idaho utilizing an Omnitronix solid-state transmitter and a top-loaded 305-foot 3-legged guyed uniform tower. The tower sides are approximately 16 inches wide on each face. The tower top is electrically connected to approximately 40 feet of three guy wires spaced 120 degree apart running from the top of the tower downward and away from the tower approximately 30 degrees from the tower.

KBLI is owned by Simmons Media Group of Salt Lake City, Utah and is leased to Radio Fiesta of Gooding, Idaho.
