Thank you very much for your letter of January 26th regarding your pickup of WGNU in Colorado Springs. Your report is all the more exciting to us, since it is the longest DX report we have received since WGNU became a 24-hour operation in March, 1980.


You did not specify whether the time was Mountain Standard or Central Standard, so I am not sure whether you heard the programs mentioned in your letter at 2:30 or 3:30 Central Time. Nevertheless, this is most impressive.

A brief summary of our programming is in order. From midnight to 6 am, we play easy-listening music (such as you heard on the 26th). From 6 am to 3 pm Monday through Friday, a variety of gospel music and programs is presented (this is also heard all day Saturday and Sunday). Then, from 3 pm to midnight Monday through Friday, we have a listener call-in program called "Party Line."

We would be particularly interested--should you pick us up while "Party Line" is on the air--to call us from Colorado Springs. If this happens, you may call (314) 652-0393 or 652-0396, or (618) 451-7737. We're always happy to hear from new listeners--no matter where they are!

As a BCB DX-er myself, I'm happy to hear that WGNU reaches as far as it does under these conditions, as the Rockies seem to be the cut-off point for signals from the West. Again, thank you very much for your reception report, and we hope this letter satisfies your request.
