CX was terrible, with no certain direction being favored, plus HNL. Oddly enough though, KDON was coming in for the only WC hrd. I have found out from Ev Johnson that that TT on 1410 was KQV, and not KVLB.

Rick Evans and my family are going over to Mendota this weekend to visit with Evand his family. He has a real nice set up there,
with one of those corner desks with shelves out on both walls. Rick
and I are taking the RX of course, but not counting them. I am giving
Ev my old loop which Ray Kraul made for me a few years ago. He has
just been gising a longwire, and I know he will like the loop. If
there is one thing that has helped me this year, it has been this loop
the CE made for me. It is so directional, it still amazes me sometimes.
The most significant feature is my ability to null Chicago 50kw like
WMAQ, WGN, etc and hear LAs next door, plus Radio Rhumbos on 560. WIND
XR is just 10 miles west of me south of Gary, Indiana.
