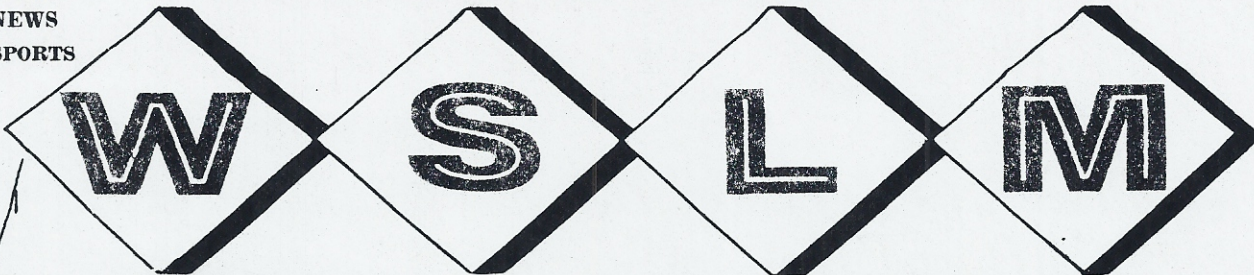

Dear Mr. Heinen:

This is to verify your DX report of 11/03/83. Our equipment here is a Continental Electronics 315B, 5000 watt transmitter using a pair of 4cx5000A's in parallel at 1220 KMz. Our antenna system is a 2-tower directional array. Both towers are 200 feet in height, spaced 437 feet apart. Our directional pattern is 5 degrees East of true North and 185 degrees South. The ground system is radials of buried copper wire 200 feet in length, spaced every 3 degrees. Thank you for your DX reprt. We shall be glad to hear from you any time you hear our station in your locality. We would like for you to DX us on our FM, at 98.9 MHz., 50,000 watts, effective radiated power.
