
I am writing to verify your reception of KLWN on 1320 KHz
2-9-81 at 3:02 a.m. CST.

KLWN is a daytime-only station with pre-sunrise authorization. As you probably are aware, such stations may operate between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. ("experimental time") for transmitter maintenance. That was what was happening that Sunday night/Monday morning when you tuned in.

You heard the 3:00 a.m. station identification, and then just a carrier because we were not doing programming at the time. Our engineer was probably just doing transmitter measurements.

KLWN operates non-directional with a single 200-foot tower with 500 watts. Our transmitter is a Harris MW-1; all solid state.
