
Dear Wayne:

This is to confirm your reception of WLUX during our special test broadcast on Saturday, October 13, 1990. As you are aware, the broadcast was arranged by the National Radio Club, and was aired from 5:30 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. Central Daylight Time.

WLUX operates on a daytime power output of 5,000 watts, with an antenna height of only 180 feet. The ground system is less than ideal, and the tower is located within a few hundred feet of a large bridge across the Mississippi River. We're told that the bridge absorbs quite a lot of the signal.

I am pleased that you were able to hear the station, and wish you continued reception success. I pray, too, that you will, or have already, heard that all-important communication, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If any man hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to him and sup with him, and he with me." That was sent forth nearly two thousand years ago by Jesus Christ, and continues to reverberate through the ages.
