Dear Wayne:

This confirms your signal report dated November 1, 1976 at 1:13 a.m. MST to 1:20 a MST. of station KOOK on 970 Khz.

KOOK operates with a transmitter output power of 5400 watts at night. Our directional antenna system for night-time consists of four 240 foot structures in a parallelogram arrangement. We transmit an effective radiated power of near 20,000 watts northward, 7,500 watts to the southwest and 2,500 watts southeastward. KOOK operates fulltime, seven days a week with the exception of the second Monday morning of each month when we discontinue normal broadcasting for technical maintenance.
