This is to verify your reception of WSJS Radio between 11:24 and 11:35 PM, EST on December 28, 1966.

Your letter was passed along to me by Leon Lasley, who is in charge of audio engineering for the WSJS Stations. We checked into the background of the engineers currently employed by the three stations, but none of them is from Buffalo. However, a former Production Department Special Writer, Dennis Maxwell was from Buffalo. He left last summer to join the General Electric Company as a writer-producer in the audio-visual department.

The WSJS Stations recently moved into new quarters, the Broadcast House we referred to on the air. The new structure was specifically designed to accomodate WSJS Radio, WSJS-FM and WSJS Television. We are quite proud of it.
