KFJM is the second oldest radio station in North Dakota and one of the oldest educational radio stations in the United States. It was first licensed on August 13, 1923. KFJM is operated by the University of North Dakota. North Dakota will be of special interest to radio DXer's. It is the original home of James Lamb, former Technical Editor of QST - Raymond Heising, the man who developed the Heising system of modulation is also a native of North Dakota - Dr. A. Hoyt Taylor, the man who invented radar, once served as head of the Physics Department at UND and was instrumental in the development of KFJM.
