12:11am Tune in as tone ended and ID given "This is KAMI Cozad Nebraska 1580 kilohertz operating with 1000 watts conducting a frequency check with Frequency Measurement Service of Denver" then more tone

12:13am ID similar to above and more tone

12:17am ID similar to above

12:20am ID similar to above except "concluding" test then you left the air.

I heard KAMI on a 1943 Vintage Navy surplus receiver using a 15" ferrite rod loop antenna. I'm located on the near north side of ~~Denver~~ Colorado Springs about 15 minutes drive from the foot of Pikes Peak.
