

Hello Dear DX Listener,

This letter is to confirm your reception of one of our AM Radio Stations.

Waitt Radio has four AM Stations here in Omaha.

1020 KOIL has a day and night pattern consisting of a 4-tower array for the day pattern with a power of 50,000 watts and a 6 tower-array pattern for night with a power of 1400 watts.

1180 KYDZ has a day and night pattern consisting of a 4-tower array with a day power of 25,000 watts and 1000 watts night.

1290 KKAR is non-directional with a power of 5000 watts day and is directional at night with a 3-tower array with a power of 5400 watts.

1620 KOZN is an extended band station and is non-directional day and night with a power of 10,000 watts day and 1000 watts night.
