We do frequency checks on a regularly scheduled basis each month at the same time, so some of your friends might try for us in the future. Maybe someday if you are fortunate, you can pick us up during the daytime. We are a 5000 watt daytime operation, and KIMN can be easily picked up after we sign off in the evening. In fact, I sometimes listen to KIMN in my car on my way home after work.

I would also like to correct your program details. The proper station identification would have been "KNFT, Bayard New Mexico." We are not licensed to Silver City, and therefore cannot use Silver City's name in our proper identification. It is, of course, in our listening area. Thank you for your letter, and I hope this information is of help to you.
