Although I'm still not sure what kind of powerful equipment you're using to pick up our station, I am very pleased to confirm that the ID, positioner phrase, programs and frequency you mentioned in your letter would in fact be KOBE, Las Cruces.

KOBE operates at 1,000 watts 24/7 and our antenna is non-directional. We've just installed a new transmitter and line to the tower, which is allowing us to be at a full 1,000 watts for the first time in years. However our new transmitter is still working out "KINKS", and not transmitting at full power all the time. I hope when we get the "KINKS" worked out that you will get a clean reception of KOBE all the time.
