
Thank you for your letter regarding the reception of our test transmission on January 18th. The purpose of the test is a monthly frequency check and is normally performed at 12:15 to 12:30AM on the third Friday morning of each month. The frequency monitoring is done by a company in Lee's Summit, MO. The February test is scheduled to be made on the morning of Feb 15th.

Last fall one morning during the test transmission I received a call from another radio hobbyist in Arizona.

For your information KRTN is a class IV station with 1000 watts of power daytime and 250 watts of nighttime power. The test transmissions are always run at 1000 watts power.
