Radio Station KSVF has been serving Artesia and the Pecos Valley since October 1946. I am enclosing a couple of stickers for Radio Station KTZA..the sister station since we are out of our last supply of KSVF stickers. KTZA is 51,000 WATTS with an antenna one thousand 91 feet above average terrain. Begining January 18, 1986 Both Radio Station KSVF and Radio Station KTZA will be broadcasting from six am to midnight seven days a week. KTZA is at 92.9 and is Stereo Rock for the Pecos Valley area.
