- 5:13pm "Stargazing" produced by Univ. of Texas
- 5:15pm KZIA sign off announcement studios & offices at 1309 San Pedro mail connects to BOX 25166 , 87125. We will return at 7:15am then off

By 5:15 your signal had begun to deteriorate badly. I heard you on a WWII Navy surplus receiver with a 14" ferrite core loop antenna. I'm located on the north side of Downtown Colorado Springs, about 6 blocks east of I-25. When not DX'ing I am an appraiser of real estate and part time advertising specialties counselor. I've been DX'ing since 1964, since 1975 from Colorado Springs, also am a member of the National Radio Club, the world's oldest and largest BCB DX club.

My number of stations on 1580 is fairly small due to KPIK, they sign off at 5pm this month which gives me 15 minutes to log KZIA. I'm enclosing return postage for your convience and I'd appreciate a verification from KZIA to my collection if my report is found correct.
