Dear Wayne:


It is indeed a pleasure to hear from you again. You remember about this time last year you send me a reception report at KCEE in Tucson, Arizona 790 Khz. I have since moved up to Las Vegas and taken over as chief Engineer of KLUC/KMJJ.

I am happy to confirm your reception report of January 10, 1981 of KMJJ, 1140Khz 10 KW Non Directional, between 4:49 P.M to 4:56 PM PST. The drop out you heard was a pattern change (a bit late I might add, normal pattern change takes place at 4:45 PM during January).

During the Day KMJJ operates with 10,000 Watts non directional. At night the power is decreased to 2,500 Watts Directional using 4 towers. Enclosed is a copy of our daytime and nighttime coverage contours. I have also enclosed one of our KMJJ bumper stickers.

Testing of KMJJ takes place during the first Monday morning (after 12:00 Mid PST/PDT) of each month. This will generally include operation at 10Kw Non directional with test messages and tones.

I will be more than happy to answer all reception reports from all DX'ers who would like a confirmation from Nevada. Thank you for your report Wayne and I look forward to hearing from you again soon.
