Thank you for your confirmation of reception of our station KQLO on 1/16/90. We appreciate you taking the time to write us. I would like to take this opportunity to confirm your reception report and confirm that the information is correct.

KQLO operates as a regional station with a daytime power of 5000 Watts daytime and 1000 watts nighttime directional. Our nulls in our pattern are to the south-southeast and north-northwest in a figure eight pattern. We operate with a Continental 5KW transmitter into two 282' towers. We also have a 1962 Bauer 5KW backup transmitter.

KQLO now broadcasts an Oldies format, different from the newstalk you monitored in January.
